



## Karsan Delivers 20 Electric Vehicles to Romania

**As the environmentalist choice of Europe with its 100% electric vehicles, commercial vehicle manufacturer Karsan delivered 14 Atak Electrics and 6 Jest Electrics to the Municipality of Dej in Romania. Karsan had won the tender funded by the European Union Regional Development Fund for the modernization of public transport systems run by the Municipality of Dej and therefore delivered 20 electric vehicles.**

With a factory based in Turkey, Karsan offers transport solutions that meet the mobility needs of the age and remains a popular choice in Europe with its fully electric public transport vehicles, Jest Electric and Atak Electric. The company has been regularly delivering orders placed throughout the year and most recently delivered 14 Atak Electrics and 6 Jest Electrics to Dej Municipality of Romania. Together with its distributor Anadolu ROM, Karsan had won the tender funded by the European Union Regional Development Fund for the modernization of public transport systems run by the municipality of Dej.

### **300 km range on a single charge**


Atak Electric belongs to the 8-meter class of Karsan's electrical product range, and produces 230 kW of motor power and 2500 Nm of torque, providing a high-performance experience to the driver. Running on a total 220 kWh battery capacity with five 44 kWh batteries developed by BMW, Atak Electric outperforms its rivals with a unique range of 300 km, and its batteries can be charged in 5 hours with AC charging, and in 3 hours with fast-charging units. The 6-meter long Jest Electric stands out with its compact design and exceptional maneuverability. Equipped with a BMW electric motor producing 135 kW power and 290 Nm torque with optional 44 or 88 kWh BMW-made batteries, Jest Electric offers a range of up to 210 km.

Celebrating its 54th anniversary in the Turkish automotive industry, Karsan has been manufacturing its own vehicles, as well as parts for the world's prominent brands in the commercial vehicles sector at its modern facilities. The company has been engaged in commercial vehicle production since 1981, and its factory in Hasanaga in Bursa has the capacity to manufacture up to 19,870 vehicles a year on a single shift. The Hasanaga factory is a flexible installation that can manufacture all kinds of vehicles in the same facilities from passenger cars and heavy trucks to minivans and buses. It is located 30 km from the Bursa city center and has been established on an area of 200,000 sqm, 90,000 sqm of which is closed space.

Karsan has been the only independent, multi-brand light commercial vehicles manufacturer in the Turkish automotive industry for more than 50 years, and in collaboration with its business partners and licensors, the company aims to develop bespoke versions of new and existing vehicles in order to extend its presence to all segments of cargo and passenger transportation in line with its vision. Working to "develop innovative products and services from the idea to the market" and to cater to every market segment, Karsan primarily aims to strengthen its Main Manufacturer/OEM business line. Karsan manages its whole automotive value chain from R&D and manufacturing to marketing, sales and after-sales activities.

Currently, the company manufactures the new H350 light commercial vehicles for Hyundai Motor Company (HMC), 10-12-18 m buses for Menarinibus and its own Jest, Atak and Star models. It also produces fully electric vehicles, its much-celebrated Jest Electric and Atak Electric line, in partnership with the world giant BMW. Besides vehicle manufacturing, Karsan also provides a range of industrial services in its Organized Industrial Zone factory.
